Can you name an experience you've had that is connected to Angkor Wat?

When I was a member of the JOY foundation and during an annual festival, in Thailand, I took part in an Apsara Dance and I felt like I was channelling the original Aspara from Cambodia.



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After that I had a dream where I went to Angkor Wat where I saw the King but her was made of stone and I saw many more people and wondered why they did not come to see the King and show respect to him. The stone King looked at me like he really loved me and I complained to him and asked why he looked at me this way. He explained that he loved me and if I ever needed something in my life or if I had worries then I could come see him and he would help in any way. I then made a trip to Angkor Wat and exactly the same place as in my dream I saw a place with a stone statue. No-one was paying attention but I knew this was the same as in my dream I feel a very strong connection there, and I feel a Past Life connection to that time, that place and to the King Suryavarman II.

How is that spiritual connection of benefit to humanity?

It is a benefit, I think, because I taught me how to balance myself and how to understand about life, Angkor Wat itself and the history. Because we know on our soul journey we have to be born to develop ourselves to reach enlightenment to clear our Karma and to reach the level that where we don't need to become reincarnated so we can ascend.

what is the good side of that connection

To be able to share that with others. In particular my students and assist them with their own life journey and have a higher quality of life through this understanding and become better people.

what is the bad side of that connection –

You see and experience a lot of suffering to be able to understand about life and enlightenment. For example I had physical allergies and a lot of detoxification and some times emotional, spiritual and mental issues however, through my training and experience I have learned how to cope and be able to help and heal myself.

Can you give me a brief description of your understanding of the energy at Angkor Wat?

It can be compared to the bodies chakras and Mother Earth with many vortices. Also I feel about how people lost their lives there many died with pain and fear and sadness so much so, there is still a lot of that energy left there that needs to be dealt with. But there is also very amazing energy there that seems to enhance me and feels very powerful and compassionate as well.

What do you feel you can bring to this experience that you would like to share with others?



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I think I'd especially like to be part of the ceremonies where people will feel the energies and how they are. We are not there as normal tourists but as spiritual healers to gain experiences and become teachers and student to learn from this together.
